

What will your child be learning this term?

ENGLISH

We will be learning to write a balanced discussion. Children will be using ,relative clauses, parenthesis, modal verbs, apostrophes for possession and rhetorical questions to hook the reader.

In addition, we will be learning to write setting descriptions.

Children will explore different features of a setting description before planning and writing a scene description.

MATHEMATICS

In Maths, we will be learning about:

Multiplication and Division Fractions



The children will explore how to solve 4-digit by 1 digit multiplication and division questions by using the formal method.

Children will be learning how to multiple fractions, find a fraction of an amount, and finally find the whole. This will build on their knowledge they attained during the first term.

SCIENCE

Life Cycles

We will be exploring different life cycles.

Children will:

- To explore similarities and differences between the life cycles of mammals and birds
- similarities and differences between the life cycles of insects and amphibians.
- To explain sexual reproduction in plants.
- To understand asexual reproduction.

Geography

North America

We will be studying North American and the water cycle.

Children will:

- Explore areas of North American on a map.
- Understand the water cycle.
- To understand the formation of waterfalls and meanders.
- To compare and contrast Plymouth as a tourist destination to a place in the USA.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

What does sacrifice mean?

Children will be exploring sacrifice and religious stories.

Children will:

- To learn how Buddhists explain suffering to the world.
- Understand the meaning of sacrifice in different contexts.
- Explore different religious stories for sacrifice.
- Explore the similarities and differences in religious stories.

Dreams and goals

We will be exploring our own dreams and goals.

Children will:

- To understand that I will need money to help me achieve some of my dreams.
- To know about a range of jobs carried out by people I know.
- To identify a job I would like to do when I grow up.
- To compare the dreams and goals of young people in different cultures.



ART

ART

We will be looking at Shackleton's Journey and how artists have portrayed journeys.

Children will do this through creating Collages, printmaking and with mixed-media outcomes.

We will be focusing on the following artists:

Richard Long. A British contemporary artist who creates abstract artwork.

Frida Kahlo. A Mexican modern artist around 1930s-1940s

Lubaina Himid. A British contemporary artist who creates representational paintings.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Outdoor PE

We will be looking at Outdoor and Adventure Activities.

Children will learn the importance of having a plan before they undertake a challenge whilst also learning how to work as a team and follow a map.

Swimming
