

What will your child be learning this term?

ENGLISH

We will be learning to write a biography.

Children will be using ,relative clauses, parenthesis, modal verbs, apostrophes for possession while they write about the life of a famous refugee.

In addition, we will be learning to write some poetry.

Children will explore different features of a list poem before planning and writing their own.

MATHEMATICS

In Maths, we will be learning about:

Multiplication and Division Fractions



The children will multiply and divide numbers by 10, 100 and 1,000. We will also explore squared and cubed numbers.

Children will be exploring and comparing fractions. They will learn how to convert mixed numbers to improper fractions, as well as how to add and subtract fractions with different denominators.

SCIENCE

Energy

We will be exploring different forms of energy.

Children will:

- To understand that both living and non-living things require energy.
- To understand that energy is transferred from one store to another.
- To explore the amounts of chemical energy stored in the food humans eat.
- To explain what a circuit requires and how energy is transferred in a circuit.

History

Ancient Rome

We will be studying the life of Romans.

Children will:

- To learn when and where the Romans lived.
- To understand who the Romans were.
- To explore who ruled the Romans.
- To understand what the Romans believed in.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

How does sacred text help Hindus understand Dharma

Children will be exploring the Hindu religion and explore the sacrifice of Dharma.

Children will:

- To explore what Dharma is.
- To be able to explain Dharma as a personal sacrifice.
- To be able to use sacred texts as a source to understand dharma.
- To understand how Rama fulfils his dharma.

Celebrating difference

We will be looking at different cultures and celebrating their differences.

Children will:

- To understand that cultural differences sometimes cause conflict.
- To understand what racism is.
- To explain the difference between direct and indirect types of bullying.
- To compare my life with people in the developing world.
